### PASTOR TOM'S PERSPECTIVE





### **Bible Adventure Begins!**

"Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, ... teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." Matthew 28:19a/20a These words of Jesus are the theme for this year. Our goal is to help students choose to follow Jesus and then to grow to become like Him! Honestly, that will take a lifetime! So, let's start now!

At a training in early August, I heard two reports that troubled my heart. A survey of Third through Fifth Graders revealed that 79% of them questioned if the Bible is true. Who are our Bible illiterate students? What do you say? I said those children who have never or have rarely been in a church. That is correct, but many children who go to church are also Bible illiterate. Why? Churches are entertaining the children instead of teaching them God's Word and how to live it. May our church and Bible Adventure be found guilty of truly teaching God's Word to these children every week. Thank You, Lord!

This Bible Adventure, which is for students at the Dallastown Area Intermediate School, begins on Wednesday, September 11, 2024. Parents need to register their 4, 5, or 6, Grader and have received a call from the BA Staff, before their child may begin. Homeschoolers may participate also, but their parents will need to provide their transportation. Registered students at the school will be picked up at 1:45 in the Red Office. They will be taken by van to Salem Christian Church at 24 Franklin Street in Jacobus.
